Regular and Children's Transfer	25 cents
Elderly & Persons with Disabilities Transfer (with PVTA E&D identification card)	10 cents

Elderly, Persons with Disabilities, and Medicare card holders are eligible for 1/2 fare when they show the driver a Statewide Access Pass or a PVTA E&D card available at the PVTA Customer Service Center. Regular fare tokens and tickets may be purchased for \$1.15 from the PVTA Customer Service Center.

To receive discount fare, one of the following identification cards must be shown to the driver each time you board:

- PVTA E&D Identification card;

Our Travel Trainers provide personalized, one-on-one instruction which takes each trainee's unique needs and abilities into account. Travel Training is provided free-of-charge except for the trainee's bus fare while training is taking place.
